As a member of the year round Make-It Club you can earn badges and win prizes by participating in our library's Make-It branded programming and checking out books and materials from our Make-It collection. Participants who earn badges as a member of the club can request special access to and reserve our Mobile Maker equipment, including green screens, video cameras, podcasting equipment, snap circuits, 3D printers, etc.

Special Access to Maker Equipment

Members who earn a badge are then allowed to request in library use of the Mobile Maker equipment related to it. For example, if you were to earn a digital media badge you would then have access to photography and videography equipment such as high-end cameras, studio lighting, green screens, etc. Members who have badges are welcome to come in and use the equipment anytime as long as it isn't being used for library programming or currently being used by another member.

In order to request equipment for a specific day and time, please contact our Children's Reference desk. Please keep in mind requests for specific times and equipment are limited to two times a month per patron and for two hour periods.
