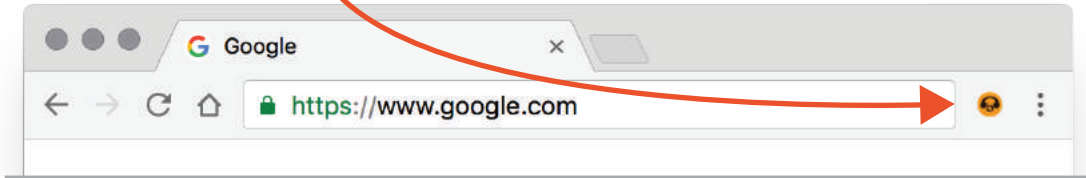


BROWSEALLOUD ACCESSIBILITY TOOLS


Browsealoud is available on these public computers when using the Google Chrome browser.

Click the [Browsealoud extension](#) in the top right corner to open the Launchpad.



Click and drag the arrow icon to move the Launchpad anywhere on the screen. Any features that are currently enabled will be **highlighted in orange**.

Most Browsealoud features can be used simultaneously.



Hover to Speak
Point the cursor anywhere on the page to start screen reading.

Selection Reading
Highlight the text you want to listen to and press the “play” button. Press “stop” to quit.

Translate
Click the globe icon and select your desired language from the dropdown menu. The page will be translated automatically. The first 40 language options can be used with screen reading.

MP3 Maker
Highlight the text you want to save and click the MP3 button. The file download will appear at the bottom of the screen. Save the file to a personal device for later listening.

Screen Mask
Click this icon to grey out most of the screen except a horizontal bar that follows the cursor.

Text Magnifier
Click this icon while using Hover-to-Speak or Selection Reading to enlarge and highlight the text being read at the top of the page.

Settings
Click this button to customize your experience with Browsealoud, including highlight colors and voice speed.



Browsealoud can also be used with online PDFs. Click the “use Browsealoud” option when opening a PDF. You may need to click “yes” to give Chrome permission to access this feature.
