Ten years after the disappearance of superhumans--both heroes and villains--thirteen-year-olds Danny and Colin begin to develop super powers, making them the object of much unwanted attention.

### **The roar, J CLAYTON**

In an overpopulated world where all signs of nature have been obliterated and a wall has been erected to keep out plague-ridden animals, twelve-year-old Mika refuses to believe that his twin sister was killed after being abducted, and continues to search for her in spite of the dangers he faces in doing so.

### **The search for WondLA, J DITERLIZZI**

Living in isolation with a robot on what appears to be an alien world populated with bizarre life forms, a twelve-year-old human girl called Eva Nine sets out on a journey to find others like her. Features "augmented reality" pages, in which readers with a webcam can access additional information about Eva Nine's world.

Martin lives in a "perfect world" under the protective dome of suburb HM1, where every year a new generation of genetically engineered children is shipped out to meet their parents. Martin has a choice either to remain in the dubious safety of HM1, or to break out of the suburb into the mysterious land outside.

### **The age altertron, J DUNN**

In a small, mid-twentieth century town that is secretly being used as a laboratory, thirteen-year-old twins Rodney and Wayne and their physicist friend, Professor Johnson, face a series of calamities including a time experiment that sends the boys from infancy to old age in just a few days.

### **The flight of the Silver Turtle, J FARDELL**

Ben, Zara, Sam, and Marcia begin their summer vacation by helping Professor Ampersand and a new friend build the Silver Turtle, a futuristic airplane, but on the day the first test flight is planned, a strange woman steals the airplane with the children inside.

### **The other side of the island, J GOODMAN**

Born in the eighth year of Enclosure, ten-year-old Honor lives in a highly regulated colony with her defiant parents, but when they have an illegal second child and are taken away, it is up to Honor and her friend Helix, another "Unpredictable," to uncover a terrible secret about their Island and the Corporation that runs everything.

### **The league of seven, J GRATZ**

When an alternate 1875 steam-driven America rediscovers electricity, the lifeblood of the Mangleborn monsters, and the secret society to protect humanity from the Mangleborn is compromised, twelve-year-old Archie must assemble a team of seven young heroes to save the world.

### **Virtually perfect, J GUTMAN**

When twelve-year-old Yip uses his father's new software to make a computer simulation of a boy his age, the creation breaks out of cyberspace into the real world and begins to complicate Yip's life.

### **A mutiny in time, J INFINITY RING**

History is broken. When best friends Dak Smyth and Sera Froste stumble upon the key to time travel -- a handheld device known as the Infinty Ring -- they're swept up in a centuries-old war for the fate of humankind.
