

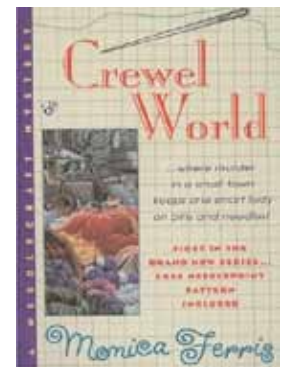
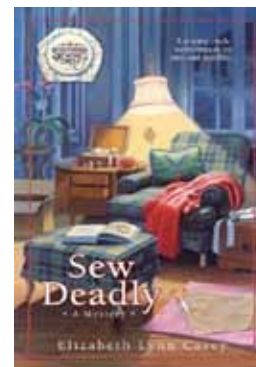
# Crafting Can be Deadly: *A Listing of Crafty Mysteries*

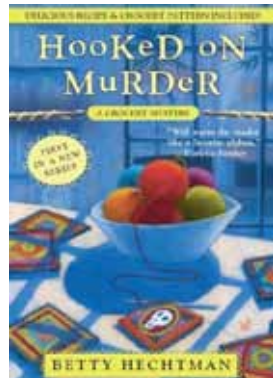
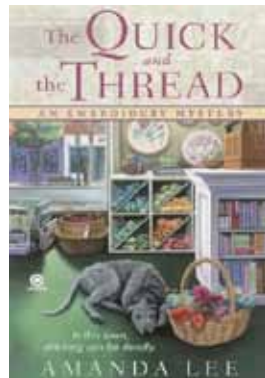


**Casey, Elizabeth Lynn.** *Sew Deadly: A Southern Sewing Circle Mystery*  
Librarian Tori Sinclaire moves down South to the small town of Sweet Briar, SC. She has joined the local sewing circle and is working on creating a life for herself in a new town. She is, however, the target of some unpleasant gossip. When a local resident is found dead at her back door, Tori is not only the subject of gossip. She becomes a suspect in the investigation led by a corrupt police officer. Will Tori be able to clear her name? Other books in this series include: *Deadly Threads*, *Pinned for Murder*, and *Deadly Notions* (2011).

**Childs, Laura.** *Keepsake Crimes: A Scrapbooking Mystery*  
Carmela Bertrand owns a popular scrapbooking shop in New Orleans. It is Mardi Gras, and the city is hopping! During a parade she and her friend see a prominent businessman be taken off a float due to illness. Little does anyone know it is fatal. Carmela's soon-to-be ex-husband is one of the main suspects. Carmela cannot believe her ex is a murderer and decides to investigate to clear his name. Other titles in this series include: *Photo Finished*, *Bound for Murder*, *Motif for Murder*, and *Frill Kill* and more.

**Ferris, Monica.** *Crewel World: A Needlecraft Mystery*  
Betsy Devonshire is getting divorced. She decides to move in with her sister Margot who owns Crewel World, a needlepoint shop in Excelsior, Minnesota. Margot has some enemies, a local competitor and her greedy landlord. A few nights after arriving Betsy comes in to find the store trashed and Margot murdered. Betsy decides to take over the business and works to find her sister's killer. The police say it was burglary, but Betsy believes otherwise. Other titles in this series include: *Framed in Lace*, *A Stitch in Time*, *Unravelling Sleeve*, and more.





**Goldenbaum, Sally.** *Death by Cashmere: A Seaside Knitters Mystery*  
Izzy Chambers is a former lawyer who has moved back to the charming coastal New England town of Sea Harbor, Massachusetts. She owns the local knitting store, which functions as a gathering place for the local knitting enthusiasts. They are a motley crew. Angelina Archer is a new arrival, come to research a local history project. She lives above Izzy's store. Angelina's body washes up in the cove, and Izzy and company decide to find out who is the killer. Other titles in this series include: Patterns in the Sand, Moon Spinners, and A Holiday Yarn.

**Hechtman, Betty.** *Hooked on Murder: A Crochet Mystery*  
Molly Pink is the event coordinator for the local bookstore in which she works. She finds the body of the leader of the weekly crochet group which meets at the bookstore. Molly and the woman have had some disagreements, and Molly becomes the top suspect. Molly must prove her innocence before she gets tangled in the murderers knots! Other titles in the series include: Dead Men Don't Crochet, By Hook or By Crook, A Stitch in Crime, and You Better Knot Die.

**Lee, Amanda.** *The Quick and the Thread: An Embroidery Mystery*  
Marcy Singer opens her new shop "The Seven Year Stitch" in Tallulah Falls, Oregon. Her shop is an instant hit, and her embroidery classes are filled. Things are going well until Marcy finds the body of the previous tenant in her storeroom. The previous owner has been murdered, and a message scratched into the wall with a tapestry needle. Marcy becomes the prime suspect and must figure out how to sew up the case for her innocence. Other titles include: Stitch Me Deadly (2011).

**Sefton, Maggie.** *Knit One Kill Two: Knitting Mystery*  
Kelly Flynn comes to Fort Connor, Colorado for her aunt's funeral. Her aunt was murdered, and the police have a vagrant in custody. Kelly's aunt's house was sold and turned into the local knitting shop, House of Lambspun. Kelly finds out that her aunt had received \$20,000 in cash the day she was murdered. The money is no where to be found. Kelly decides to investigate. Other titles in this series include: Needed to Death, A Deadly Yarn, A Killer Stitch, and more!

**Slan, Joanna Campbell.** *Paper, Scissors, Death: A Kiki Lowenstein Scrap-N-Craft Mystery*  
Kiki Lowenstein is a scrapbook enthusiast living in St. Louis with her husband and daughter. Her husband dies unexpectedly. Kiki thinks he may have been murdered. She finds out her husband was not the man he appeared. He had affairs on the side and left her nearly penniless. Her husband's mistress is murdered, and Kiki becomes the prime suspect. **Thayer, Terri.** *Wild Goose Chase: Quilting Mystery*  
Dewey Pellicano has tried to escape from quilting her entire life. When her mother, an avid quilter dies, Dewey comes home to help out at Quilter Paradiso, her mother's store. The business comes with a steep learning curve and a conniving employee, Dewey's sister in law. When celebrity quilter Claire Armstrong offers to buy the shop, Dewey is ready to accept. Claire, however, is found murdered. Dewey and the handsome detective hit it off, but then there is another murder. Will Dewey help find the killer before they sew her up for good?
