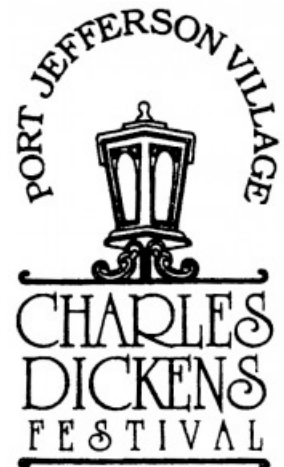
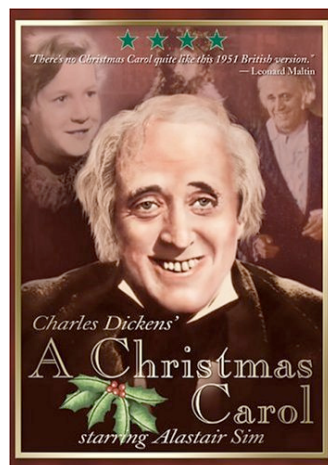
### Ye Old Main Library
