Cost: \$1 per hour.

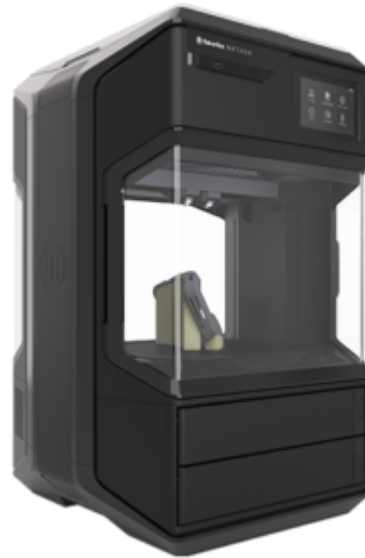
Programs are offered periodically for all age groups.

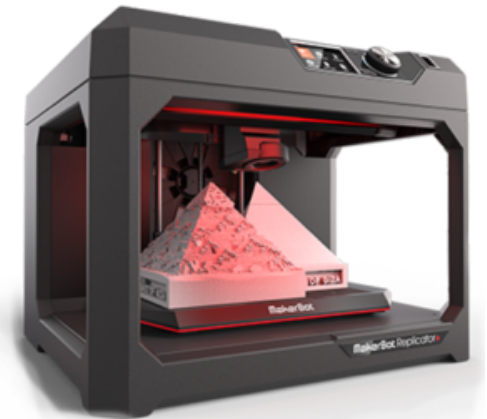

# 3D Print Service

at Port Jeff Library

## Step 1: Create or Obtain a File

### Looking for a model that already exists?

Search an open source website such as Thingiverse or 3D Warehouse.

### Looking to design your own model?

3D Computer Generated software can be free, open source, and browser-based. Try Tinkercad, Blender, or OpenSCAD.

## Step 2: Format your File

Check your design for holes, gaps, or other problems before submission.



Consider the density of the object and note that increasing density increases time and the cost.



If your model includes multiple parts, export each part as a separate STL file.



Maximum size is  
304.8 x 304.8 x 304.8 mm  
(12 x 12 x 12 in).

## Step 3: Submit your File to Print

Once your model is ready to go, submit your file through our 3D Printed Object Request Form from:

[portjefflibrary.org/3Dprintrequest](http://portjefflibrary.org/3Dprintrequest)

A staff member from the Library will contact you within five business days to go over any necessary details and to give you an estimate for the total cost (**\$1 per hour**) and estimated print time.
